Profile Information

Completing your profile allows you to share your contact information, website address and other information, such as what type of clay you use and how you fire and form your work, with MNWCA members and the interested public. Your profile also captures your mentoring interest and skills.

To complete your profile,

- 1) Login at <http://www.mnwca.org/> using your email and password. Don't know your password? To reset your password, point your browser to <http://www.mnwca.org/Sys/ForgottenPasswordRequest>.
- 2) Under your name in the top right corner of the page, click on **View profile** in turquoise.
- 3) On the **My Profile Page**, click the grey **Edit profile button** at the top of the page to make changes to your contact information, artist statement, profile picture, etc.
- 4) Click **Save** at the bottom of the page to record your responses.
- 5) To view how your information will be displayed in the member directory, click **My Directory Profile** link at the top of the page.

Member Photo Albums

All members are provided one photo album with up to 50 photographs and are displayed on your individual profile page in the Member Directory. The photos are available for the public to and for you to showcase your work. To add images to your Member Photo Album:

- 1) Login at <http://www.mnwca.org/> using your email and password. Don't know your password? To reset your password, point your browser to <http://www.mnwca.org/Sys/ForgottenPasswordRequest>.
- 2) Under your name in the top right corner of the page, click on **View profile** in turquoise.
- 3) Click on the turquoise **Member Photo Albums** link near the top of the page. If you click on "Edit Profile", you will not be able to access the photo album.
- 4) Click on the **Create an Album** button.
- 5) Please type in the **Title** of your album (required). The title should accurately describe the album's contents.
- 6) If desired, add a brief album **Description**, which will be displayed as a subheading when the album is opened by others.
- 7) Click on **Upload Photos**. You are allowed to upload up to 5 photos as a time. Images display in the order in which they are uploaded.
- 8) In order to maximize MNWCA's website capacity, **please configure each image as follows:**

This image configuration will ensure that each file is at or under 600 KB:

- **Color space: RGB**

- JPGs are already configured with RGB color

- If your files use CMYK color space, you will not be able to see the actual images after the upload.

- **Dimension on longest edge: 9 inches** (or 864 pixels)

- **Resolution (or pixels per inch): 96 ppi**

- 9) Your photos should now appear in the album. Click on any image to access the turquoise **Add Caption** button. You may choose to add more information about your image here (e.g. materials used, type of firing, dimensions HxWxD, etc).
- 10) You can add photos at any time by clicking on the **Upload Photos** button in **Member Photo Albums**. Remember that images will display in the order in which they are uploaded.
- 11) To edit the title of your album or its description, click on the **Edit Details** button in **Member Photo Albums**.
- 12) You can delete the entire album by clicking on the **Delete Album** button in **Member Photo Albums**.

Members' intranet and online community

The MNWCA website offers several avenues for communicating with other members:

- To email any member through the website, do Members/Member Directory and just start typing the member's name. Click on their name and select 'Send Message'.
